

2010 Secretary's Operational Directives

Directives for LAD

- Acquire and distribute 200,000 hectares of land (funded target of DAR).
- Rationalize the deployment of technical personnel in the field and provide extra incentives to those who have to deliver more than the average.
- Complete ARB Profiling since this is a commitment to Congress and mainstream the ARB profiling for 2010 and onwards

Directives for Support Services Delivery

- In addition to the operational directives issued by Usec. Bistoyong, we have to do the following based on RA 9700 or the CARPER Law:
 - For the DAR to establish as far as practicable two (2) ARCs per Legislative District with predominant agricultural population. For CY 2010, confirm & launch at least 1 ARC per province
 - Also, operationalize ARC Clusters, 1 per province, pursuant to MC 13 series of 2009

Formulate policies / guidelines on the use of purchase orders, marketing agreement or expected harvests as collateral for loans of ARBs.

- Facilitate ARBs' access to socialized terms of agricultural credit and subsidy
- Increase the membership in all assisted organizations
- Operationalize women's desk in ARCs and DAR offices at all levels
- Revitalize landowner's desk to focus on facilitating investment assistance for Landowners
- Implement LTI-PBD integration based on AO 5, Series of 2009 especially in areas with high LAD balances
- Fast track the completion of all infrastructure projects, locally-funded as well as foreign assisted

Directives for AJD

- Prioritize LAD-related, ageing, flashpoint and cases involving bigger hectarages in the disposition and resolution of AR cases.
- Speed up the resolution of DARAB and ALI cases without compromising the qualitative aspect
- Continue the aggressive utilization of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) schemes
- Full operationalization of Enhanced Legal Case Monitoring System (eLCMS)

Directives for Finance, Management and Administration

- Integration of all values and anti-corruption programs in all sectors
- Intensify the monitoring of implementation, and review of systems and procedures for improved efficiency and effectiveness
- Capacity Development of DAR Personnel
