The Department of Agrarian Reform, Quezon II Provincial Office through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invites all interested practicing licensed Geodetic Engineers and partnership or corporations authorized to engage in the business of land surveying and mapping to apply for eligibility and shortlisting and if found eligible and shortlisted, to bid for the hereunder project:

The works shall include the furnishing of all labor materials, supplies and all instruments/equipment for the 1.) execution of the boundary and subdivision survey, 2.) fabrication/provision of standard "AR" cyl. conc. mons. on all corners of the resulting lots, 3.) preparation and submission of complete and acceptable survey returns for verification and approval by the LMS-DENR, and 4.) submission to DARPO of one (1) Sepia copy of each ASP, eight (8) blue print copies of ASPs and Lot Technical Description sheets.

The list of minimum requirements is indicated in the Eligibility Form. Eligibility of prospective bidders shall be checked using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria. Shortlisting of eligible consultants will be done based on the following criteria: experience of the consultant, qualification of personnel and current workload. The evaluation procedure to be adopted shall be Quality Cost Based Evaluation (QCBE).

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-Bidding Conference(s), Evaluation of Bids, Post-Qualification and Award of Contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of R.A. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR).

The Eligibility Screening Form will be available on May 17-21, 2010 at Survey Section Operations Division, DARPO, 3rd Flr. L.M. Tañada Bldg., Gumaca, Quezon. Upon submission of a letter of intent and payment of a non-refundable fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) per set. Deadline for the submission of duly accomplished application for eligibility and other documentary requirements shall be on May 26, 2010. Results of eligibility shall be posted at DARPO Q2 web site and shortlisted bidders shall be notified through writing.

Pre-bid conference for all shortlisted bidders is on June 2, 2010 Wednesday, 9:00a.m. at DARPO Conference Hall, L.M. Tañada Bldg., Gumaca, Quezon. Bid documents will be available on the same date upon payment of a non-refundable amount of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per project to the Cashier.

Sealed bids in four (4) copies of the DAR Projects listed above will be received by the Chairman, Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) at DAR Provincial Office, Gumaca, Quezon and will be publicly opened immediately after at 9:00 a.m. on June 9, 2010.

The Department of Agrarian Reform Quezon II Provincial Office assumes no responsibility whatsoever to compensate or indemnify bidders for all expenses incurred in the preparation of the bid.
