INVITATION TO BID

The Government of the Philippines, through the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), has received an ODA Loan from JAPAN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGENCY, herein referred to as JICA, (formerly, JAPAN BANK FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION, JBIC), which intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of the loan to Agrarian Reform Infrastructure Support Project Phase III (ARISP III) in the total amount of Sixteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P16,500,000.00), exclusive of tax, to payments for the procurement of motorcycles.

The DAR, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), is inviting prospective bidders to bid for 130 units of motorcycles. The motorcycles will be used by DAR- staff in monitoring or project implementation in the Agrarian Reform Communities (ARCs) because the terrain in most areas is from rolling to mountainous where four-wheel vehicle is not suitable.

Bidding will be conducted through competitive bidding procedures specified in the Japan Bank for International Cooperation's Local Competitive Bidding procedures and in accordance with R.A. No. 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

The DAR BAC shall not entertain any transactions related to this procurement on Saturdays, Sundays and declared holidays from the start of advertisement of this ITB until the approval of the Contract with the winning bidder for this procurement.
