INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID

The Government of the Philippines, through the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), has received an ODA Loan from JAPAN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGENCY, herein referred to as JICA, (formerly, JAPAN BANK FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION, JBIC), and now towards the costs of Agrarian Reform Infrastructure Support Project Phase III (ARISP III), and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of the loan in the total amount of Fifteen Million Six Hundred Pesos (P15,600,000.00) to payments under the contract of procurement of equipment.

The DAR Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is inviting contractors to bid for the following equipment under one lot:

- 100 units of Desktop Computer with Accessories
- 60 units of Laptop Computer
- 60 units of LCD Projector
- 90 units of Digital Camera

Bidding will be conducted through national competitive bidding procedures specified in the Japan Bank for International Cooperation's Local Competitive Bidding procedures and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries defined in the "Guidelines for Procurement under JBIC ODA Loans".

The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or its authorized representative upon presentation of Official Receipt of payment to BAC Secretariat.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid security, in the form and amount specified in the Bidding Documents, ITB, and in pursuance with the provisions of Sec. 27 of the IRR-A of R.A. 9184.

The DAR BAC will not entertain any transactions related to this procurement on Saturdays, Sundays and declared holidays from the start of advertisement of this IAETB until the approval of the Contract with the winning bidder for this procurement.

The DAR BAC reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and accept the most advantageous to the Government.
